Reporting directly to the **Design Team Leader**, the Design Technician is responsible preparing technical designs for HVAC control systems from preliminary concepts, sketches, calculations, specification sheets and other data. The incumbent will review plans and confer with project managers, estimating team, programmers, and electricians to meet project specifications, complete documentation packages and produce drawing sets.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

- reading and interpreting plans, as well as complex mechanical and electrical specifications; and developing an appropriate building management system in line with plans and specifications
- using AutoCAD to design and draft schematic control and electrical wiring diagrams, sequences of operation and bills of materials for the building management system requested in the engineering drawings
- selecting and sizing the various control equipment at the digital (controllers, computers, etc.), electrical (transformers, relays, etc.) and mechanical (valves, actuators, etc.) levels for approval purposes
- creating working drawings using AutoCAD following established company standards
- laying out and sizing mechanical systems as directed
- maintaining and updating drawings to reflect any change requests
- organizing and printing drawing sets as requested in a timely fashion
- reviewing drawings for quality control
- setting up drawings in an organized fashion and ensuring appropriate labelling
- storing, managing and archiving drawing files and recording sets of drawings in accordance with company Project Management Standards
- storing and managing project documentation in accordance with AEM's Project Management Standards
- communicating with other departments on a project by project basis
- collaborating with internal project managers, electricians, and programmers to complete projects on time and on budget.
- interacting with customers and consultants as needed throughout the course of a project
- communicating effectively with team leaders about current projects and any recommendations for process improvements
- respecting the values and code of ethics of the company
- all other related tasks
